

This CRStar Insight is provided to give users who are abstracting <u>2023 cases</u> a better understanding about possible edits they may not be able to clear.

Several new EOD Schemas have been added for AJCC v9 for 2023. CRStar calculates these new schemas correctly but the new IDs do not exist in 2022 metafiles; therefore, any case with a 2023 schema change may produce edits that cannot be cleared. These cases will need to be held until the 2023 upgrade is applied in April.

Sites with new schemas for 2023:

- Anus
- Appendix
- Brain
- CNS Other
- Intracranial Gland
- Medulloblastoma

Common edit messages triggered by these sites include:

- "...not a valid value for Schema ID"
- "Reported Schema ID not valid for..."
- "Grade ... is invalid" (Clinical and/or Path)
- "SSDI ... invalid ... must be blank"
