SEE NOTE BELOW regarding the entry and reporting of the NEW Surgery text fields.

As of March 1, 2018, CRStar will handle surgery text differently within the abstract and exports. This change will require the user to run reports differently as of this date. The State of California requires three separate text fields instead of the singular field as in the past. The rationale is that for each surgical procedure performed, a unique text field be entered. Each of the text fields will allow 333 characters. If more than three surgical procedures are performed, it is necessary to fit the additional procedure's text in the 3rd position.

Although the dates and codes replicate to the CA State2 for each row entered, the text entered on the treatment tabs does not transfer. **The state wants the user to break it down per procedure** and not as one entry.
 Text information entered on the state screen does NOT transfer to the Surgery text field on the treatment screen.
 The user can copy and paste, but CRStar will not auto populate.
 When running reports, the user will need to know which fields to include based upon the date abstracted and utilization of fields.

Surg: This is text entered on the TREATMENT SCREEN

Notice, the text is different between the treatment summary screen and the CA State 2 screen.

When exporting, the system will look for surgery text on the CA State screen2 and if the CA Surgery Text fields are blank, then the system will export the details from the surgery text from the Treatment tab. There is no need to resubmit older cases or re-abstract cases entered prior to March 2, 2018.

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
