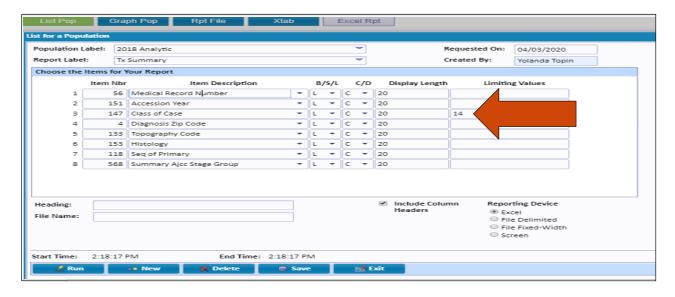
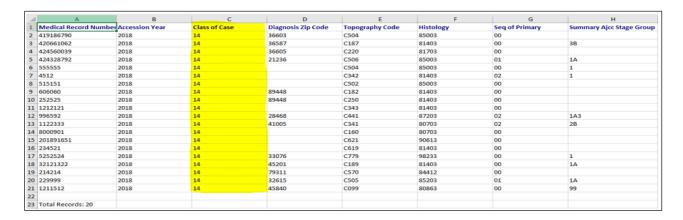

Using Limiting Values in a List Pop Report

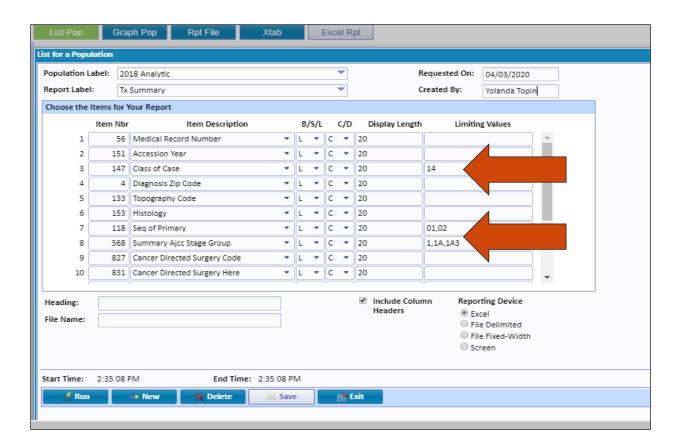
In the Reporting Module, under Ad hoc Reports, is the List Pop tab. The use of limiting values in a List for Population is especially useful for limiting criteria on a previously selected population. By utilizing any report label within CRStar, the user can apply limiting values when running a list pop report. Entering values in this field limits the details of the report. Multiple values may be entered using a comma (no space) between the data values.



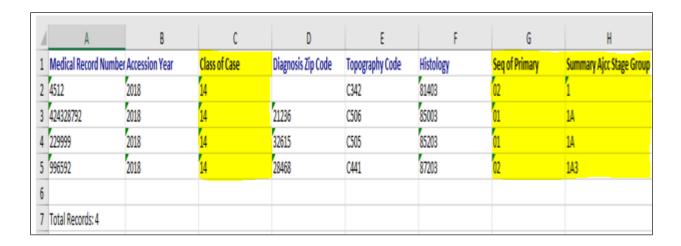
In the List for a Population above, the user selects the class of case field and limits the value to only class 14. As seen in the report below, this results in only cases with a class of 14 in the selected population showing up on the report.







The report below now shows only cases that are class 14, with a sequence of 01 and 02, and summary stage group of 1, 1A, and 1A3.



In conclusion, the user enters limiting values for a specific data field to help limit the details of a report.
