Exporting Cases to the State of California

The intent of this Insight is to demonstrate how to select and submit cases for the state of CA using both select a population and the state export tab in CRStar. The state report flag is changed from an “Y” to an “T” after exporting the data. Any modifications to the case after reporting the case to the state will result in the state report flag changing to a “C”.

Select the appropriate population from the drop-down box or create a population by naming the report and selecting all cases where state report flag is coded to a “Y” as shown below.

Click on Reporting then Data Exports and then State export. The correct file extensions are already applied to the file upon export. See example of the report below.

To select the cases for the correction export, select the population as shown below. This report is based on state report flag = C .

After selecting the cases, click on Reporting then Data Exports and State Export.

Choose the population for the corrected cases from the drop-down box and select the options as shown below, naming the file as desired. The file automatically provides the XMO extension (You DO NOT HAVE to type it in). The state report flag is changed from an “C” to an “T” after exporting the data. Any modifications to a case, after reporting the case to the state, will result in the state report flag changing to a “C”.
